- To address any grievances raised by SC/ST students promptly and effectively.
- To improve the employability of SC/ST students by offering tailored career guidance and support.

Activities can be given:

- The Cell can provide guidelines to the office staff concerning the admission process for SC and ST students, as necessary.
- The Cell can provide discussions on various scholarships available to eligible students.
- Information regarding government and university schemes can be disseminated by the Cell.
- Encouragement can be provided to students to participate in skill development programs offered by the College.
- In addition to personal counseling, departments can offer remedial coaching to students.
- Advanced learners can be encouraged to assist weaker students in enhancing their academic performance.
