Founded in 2013, the college is affiliated with the University of Calicut.

COURSES OFFERED

The college provides 10 affiliated programs, including BA in English, BSc in Physics, BSc in Chemistry, BSc in Mathematics, BSc in Food Science & Technology, BBA, B.Com in Computer Applications, B.Com in Travel & Tourism, M.Com in Finance, and MSc in Food Science & Technology.

STAFF & STUDENTS

The success of an educational institution hinges on its teachers and students. At MSTM College, we are proud to have faculties of highly qualified, knowledgeable, and of empathetic attitude who are passionate about sharing their love for their subjects with students. Our faculty is always ready to adapt and innovate to meet new challenges and demands, aiming to bring out the best in their students. We have 49 teaching staff and 8 non-teaching staff, with a total student enrollment of 1085 across various subjects.

INFRASTRUCTURE FACILITIES

Classrooms: Our college boasts of 29 well-equipped classrooms, each featuring a whiteboard, lecture stand, fans, lights and the necessary seating arrangements for students.

Seminar Hall: We have well-organized seminar halls with appropriate seating arrangements, IIP panels, and other necessary equipment.

Restrooms: We provide an adequate number of restrooms for female students.

Computer Lab: Our college has well-furnished computer labs with 24 computers available for student use.

Science Labs: We offer spacious and well-equipped labs for Physics, Chemistry, Microbiology, and Food Science & Technology. These labs provide students in the BSc Physics, BSc Chemistry, BSc Microbiology, BSc Food Science & Technology, and MSc Food Science & Technology programs with the proper and adequate exposure to experimental work.

Library: The college library is well-equipped, featuring a well-furnished hall and over 5,000 books on various subjects. In addition to these books, numerous periodicals, journals, and newspapers are available for students.

Playground: The college has a standard-sized playground for students' physical training.

This workshop helps to prepare for the upcoming process of accreditation and it throws a light on our preparedness and helps in collecting relevant inputs for each criterion. The members were also familiarized with the processes involved in SOP (Standard Operation Procedure), essential metrics and opt-out metrics, considering the qualitative and quantitative metrics with appropriate supporting documents. The session strived to achieve the core value for excellence among the participants. The session was closed at 4:30 pm.

II. NSS ACTIVITIES

1) WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY

The NSS Unit of our college conducted World Environment Day programme ‘*Clean and Green Home Challenge*’ and *Nature Photography Contest* held on June 5th 2021 was a celebration of our planet's natural

Due to lockdown measures, the celebration was organized with limited physical attendance and strict adherence to safety protocols. 4) FOGGING AND CLEANING

The NSS (National Service Scheme) unit at MSTM Arts and Science College was established on 1st December 2020, sanctioned by the University of Calicut. It is the first and only one NSS unit of our College.

The NSS unit of our College underwent a significant transformation from being a self-funded unit to becoming a funded unit with effect from 11/11/2022, marked by a change in unit number from SF12 to 277 sanctioned by the University of Calicut. This transition represents a milestone in the unit's journey towards greater support and sustainability.

7) Isha and Ivan Fund

The NSS Unit of our College organized a fund collection programme aimed at supporting the Isha and Ivan Chikitsa Sahaya Samithi for Kidney and Liver Transplantation. The event took place on 26/11/2021 and saw
