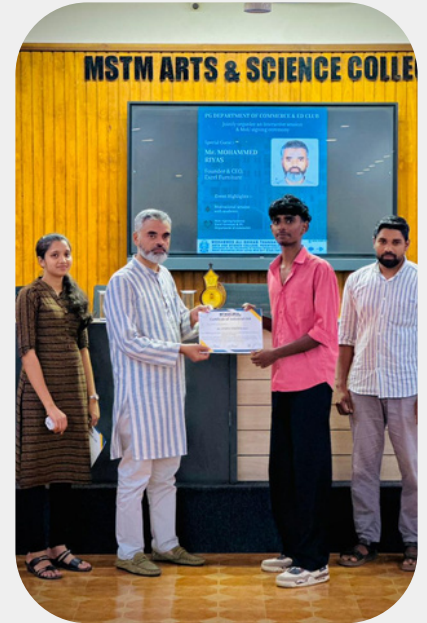




## MOU SIGNING CEREMONY

The observance of the International Day of the Girl Child by the Department created a meaningful impact in the school setting and reflected the department's commitment to community engagement and gender awareness.







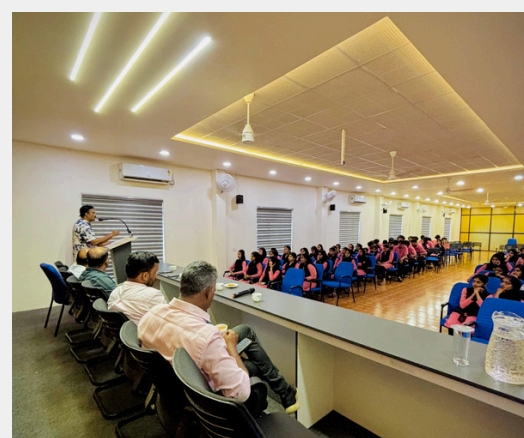
## OBSERVATION OF INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR THE ERADICATION OF POVERTY

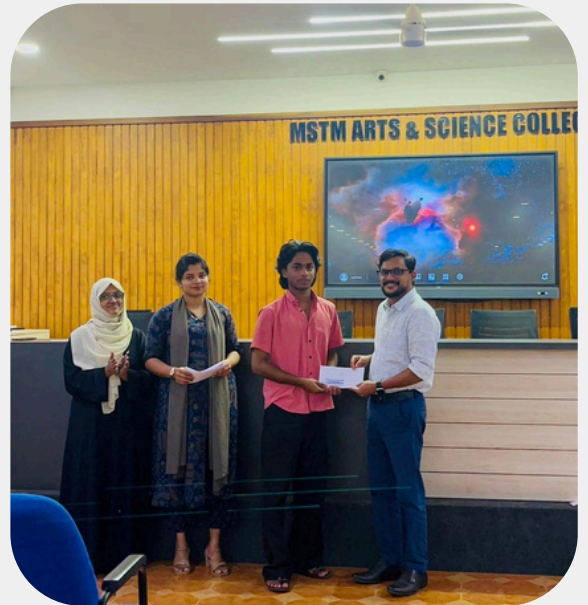




## WORLD STATISTICS DAY
