## THE WORLD AIDS DAY PROGRAMME

The World AIDS Day 2025 programme, held on December 1, successfully fostered a spirit of solidarity and education under the theme of overcoming global disruptions in HIV care. The event featured a series of interactive workshops and public health seminars that emphasized the latest medical breakthroughs, such as long-acting prevention injectables, and the critical importance of the “Undetectable = Untransmittable” (U=U) message. By engaging local healthcare professionals and community leaders, the programme provided a safe platform for dialogue, effectively reaching numerous participants and distributing essential resources to help bridge gaps in public awareness.

Beyond the immediate activities, the programme made significant strides in reducing social stigma and promoting equitable access to testing services. Through a combination of voluntary counseling drives and a vibrant digital campaign, a measurable shift in community attitudes toward HIV-positive individuals was observed, moving from fear toward informed support. Feedback collected indicated that the event not only met its goal of increasing testing literacy but also reinforced a collective commitment to the global target of ending the AIDS epidemic by 2030, while laying out a roadmap for sustained advocacy throughout the coming year.





## **FOOTBALL CARAVAN AT MSTM**

As part of an initiative to promote football culture and sporting awareness among youth, the Football Caravan 2025 was successfully conducted in Malappuram district on 2 December 2025.     - Literary Performances: Elocution in English, Malayalam, and Arabic, along with Mono-Act performances

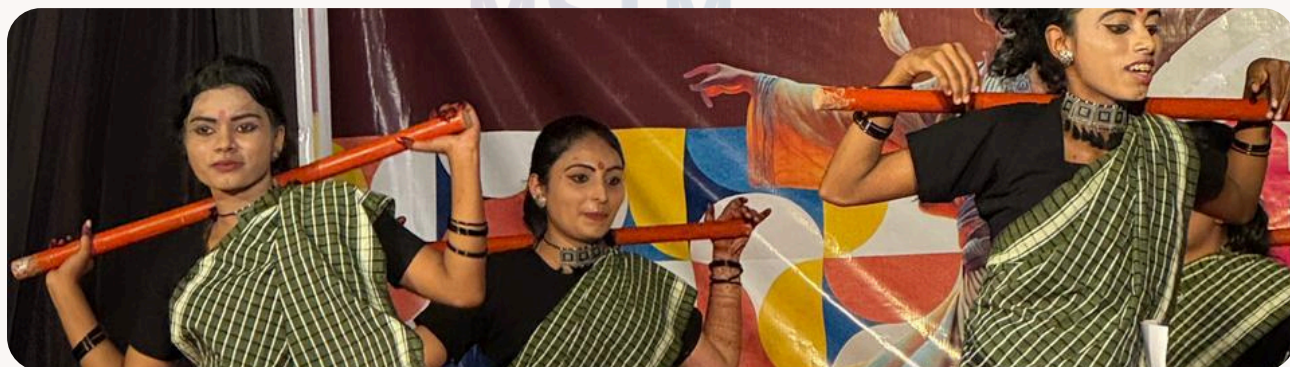


- Off-Stage Events (19 Events): Off-stage competitions, conducted prior to and alongside the main fest day, showcased students' creativity and craftsmanship:

The visit proved to be informative and enriching, offering students valuable experiential learning beyond the classroom. It left a positive impression and contributed meaningfully to their academic and personal development.



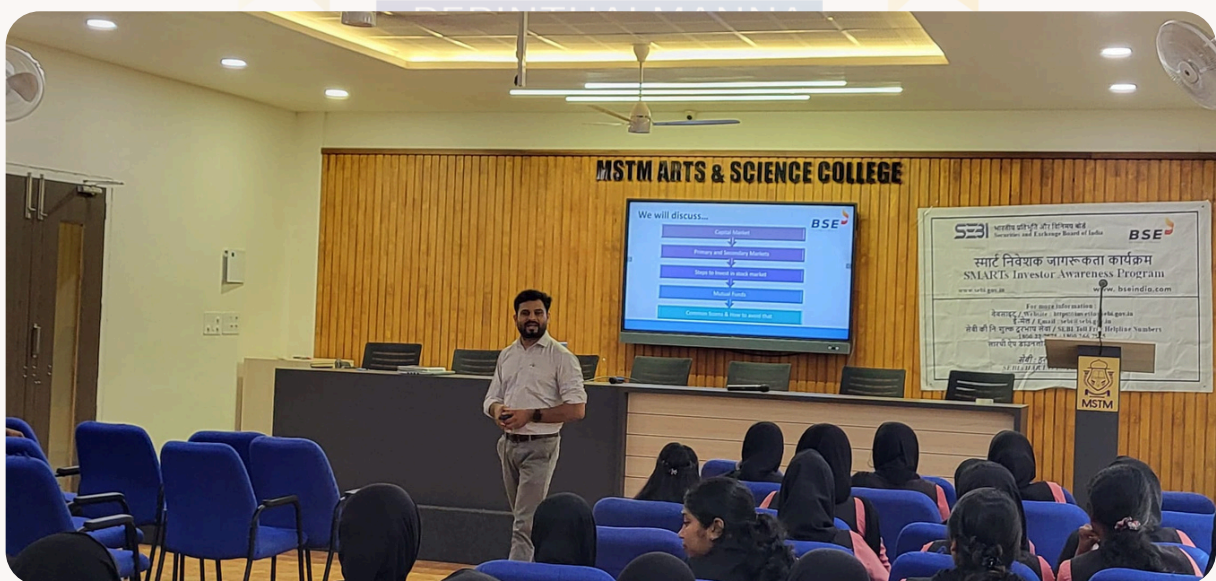
## **INVESTOR AWARENESS PROGRAMME**

Their participation reflects the growing sports culture of the institution and the encouragement provided by the college to nurture athletic talent.



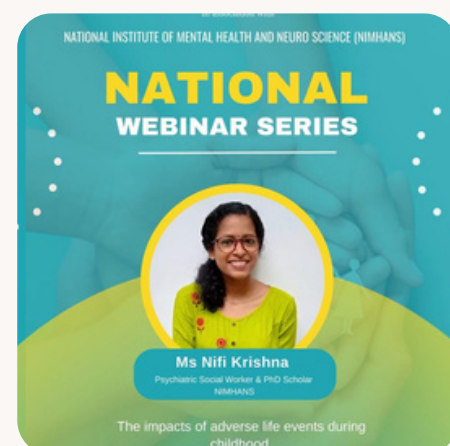
## **NATIONAL WEBINAR SERIES CONCLUSION**

The programme commenced on 29 November 2025 with an inaugural session by Dr. Kavita V. Jangam, Additional Professor and PSW Consultant, NIMHANS, who provided a comprehensive introduction to Child and Adolescent Mental Health (CAMH).

This was followed by an insightful session by Dr. Priyanka Nambiar, Assistant Professor, CHRIST (Deemed to be University), Bengaluru, focusing on parental alienation and child custody issues.



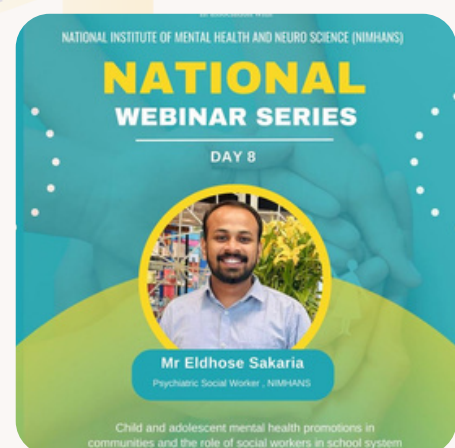


The subsequent sessions further enriched participants' understanding of the field. Ms. Glory Kumari, Psychiatric Social Worker and PhD Scholar, NIMHANS, discussed key developmental stages and common mental health disorders in childhood and adolescence. Mr. Shamil, Psychiatric Social Worker and PhD Scholar, NIMHANS, addressed the critical issue of self-harm and suicide among children, emphasizing multisystemic intervention strategies.

Adding further depth to the series, Ms. Nifi Krishna, Psychiatric Social Worker and PhD Scholar, NIMHANS, delivered a session on the impact of adverse life events during childhood. Dr. Asim Ur Rahman, Assistant Professor, Jindal Institute of Behavioral Sciences, presented on preliminary assessment and rehabilitation counselling for children in conflict with the law. Mr. Ajmal P, Psychiatric Social Worker and PhD Scholar, NIMHANS, elaborated on social work assessments and interventions in child and adolescent mental health.

The webinar series concluded on 27 December 2025 with a session by Mr. Eldhose Sakaria, Psychiatric Social Worker, NIMHANS, who highlighted community-based child and adolescent mental health promotion and the vital role of social workers within school systems.
