The programme also featured special activities, including a free ear-piercing camp and a session honouring teachers, which added value to the celebration and encouraged active participation among students and staff.

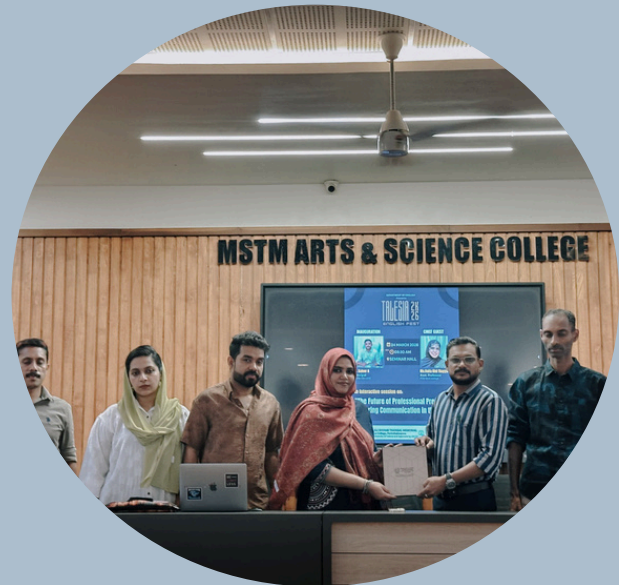
