World Food Safety Day 2026 Celebration

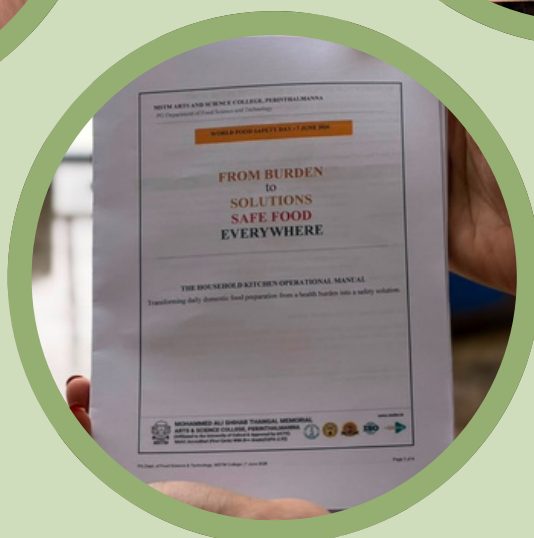
